

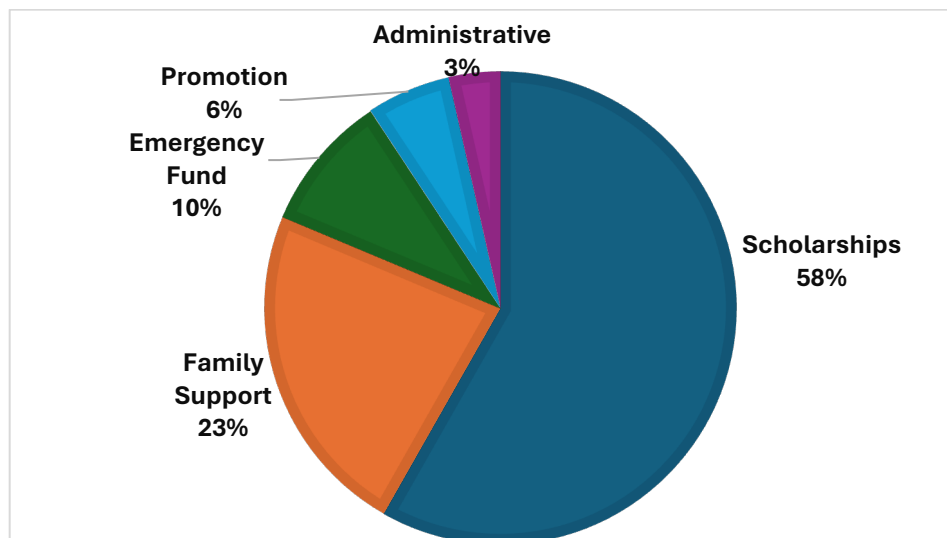
MidCoast New Mainers Group (MCNMG)

2025 – Our Community Involvement and Impact: A Quick View

In 2025 our impact grew significantly. The reach of our involvement goes far beyond the financial resources we used to assist New Mainer individuals and families. Our impact relies on the rich network of volunteers, community stakeholders, and the immigrant community we have fostered in the eight years we have been active in this work.

More than 50 volunteers each donated hundreds of hours serving as family mentors, drivers, and resource people (e.g., job coaching). Community members donated household goods, furniture, and seasonally appropriate clothing to families. **Volunteers supporting the New Mainer community are invaluable.** They not only amount to thousands of unpaid hours of direct assistance to New Mainers, **this work creates vital connection between the wider community and local New Mainers.**

In 2025, MCNMG provided **direct financial assistance to more than 100 people in 83 families**, a substantial increase in our outreach from the estimated 30 families we assisted in 2024.



91% of MCNMG expenditures in 2025 went directly to assisting New Mainer individuals and families.
